QUESTION:

Mr T P Mogale (EFF) to ask the Minister of Human Settlements:

- (1) Whether she has been informed of allegations of corruption involving the allocation of RDP houses by municipal officials and councillors in the Musina Local Municipality; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so, what specific action has she taken to (a) investigate the allegations and (b) ensure accountability;
- (2) what measures have been implemented to prevent further manipulation of housing allocation processes in the specified municipality? NW3391E

REPLY:

1. According to the response received from the Limpopo Department of Co-operative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs, no complaints or allegations of corruption regarding the allocation of RDP houses in Musina Local Municipality have been brought to their attention.
2. The Provincial Department has developed a Provincial Allocation Policy which governs the allocation of housing opportunities across municipalities. All municipalities are required to adhere to the provisions of this policy, which incorporates data from the National Housing

Needs Register to promote fair, transparent, and needs-based allocation of housing opportunities.
