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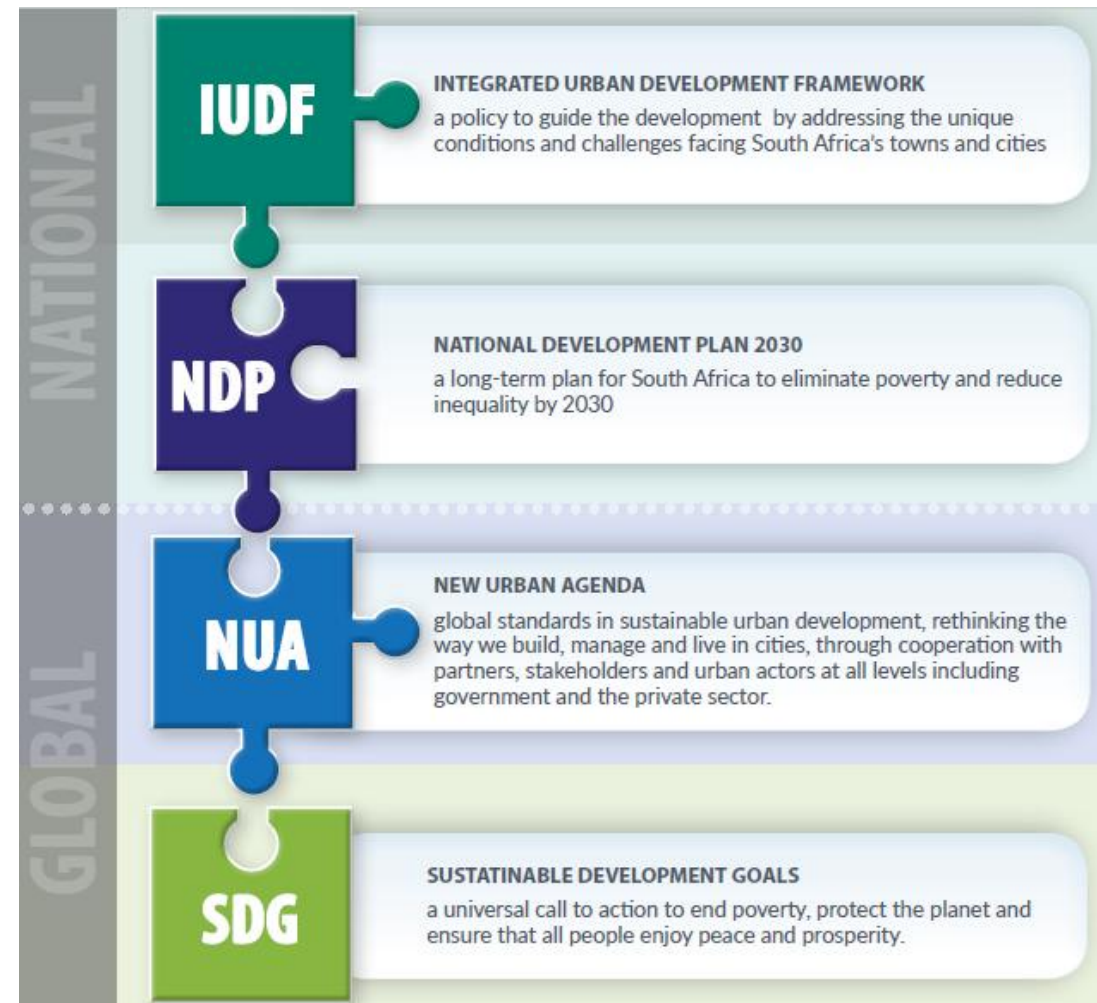
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Project Background

- The SACN will be supporting the National Department of Human Settlements (DHS) to develop a framework for implementing the New Urban Agenda (NUA).
- Considered within the context of South Africa's existing urban policy context and in particular the IUDF.
- Task is to support the creation of a domestic, locally embedded framework for interpreting the New Urban Agenda (NUA) and its associated commitments within the South African urban policy context.

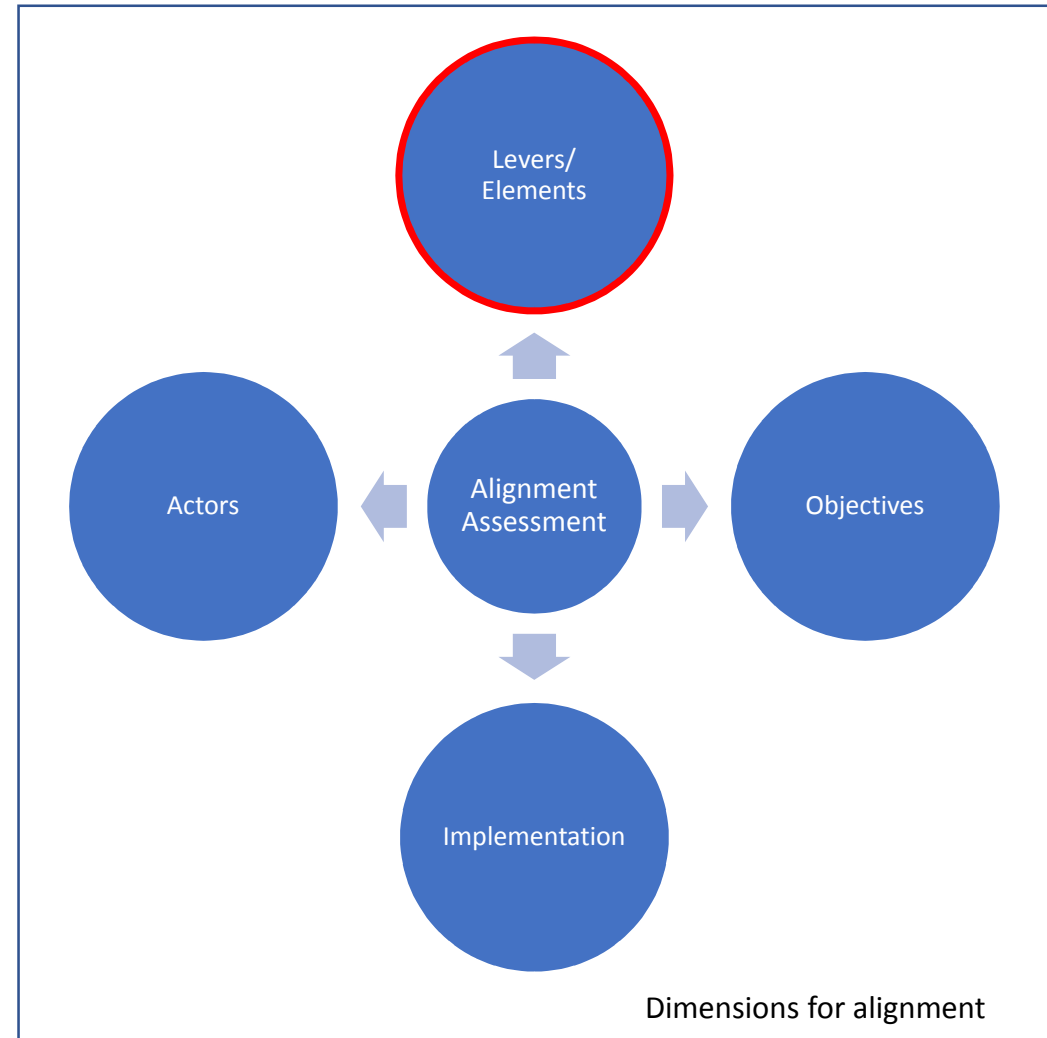
Project Objectives

- To develop a **draft framework for localizing and implementing the New Urban Agenda (NUA-LF)**, including inputs from the following:
 - Participants at Commission 3 of the Human Settlements Summit
 - Identified sector stakeholder consultations
 - Engagements at the World Cities Day event on 31 October 2017.



Alignment Matrix

- First step in the project
- The intention is to provide as comprehensive an assessment of the alignment between the IUDF and NUA as possible
- The initial attempt has focused on alignment of levers/ elements between IUDF and NUA
- Further work will assess other 'dimensions' of alignment

- An assessment was done of the NUA and the IUDF
- Key elements/ levers terms were correlated
- The tenets were cross referenced to determine the linkages and whether they are clear or implied no linkage
