QUESTION:

5108. Mr C J Poole (DA) to ask the Minister of Human Settlements:

- (1) What are the reasons behind the discrepancies of backlogged government subsidised properties between the Surveyor-General and deeds office data;
- (2) whether her department maintains its own database of government subsidised properties (a) built and (b) to be built; if not, why not in each case; if so, what are the relevant details in each case;
- (3) what total number of government subsidised properties has been transferred from the 78 658 specified properties that were in the deeds office data in March 2025? NW5716E

REPLY:

- 1. The Deeds Office data refers to government-owned residential properties where an organ of state is reflected as the registered owner. These properties are required to be transferred to individual beneficiaries. The Surveyor-General data relates to land parcels that have not yet been proclaimed and therefore require township proclamation before individual transfers can be effected.
- 2. a) The Department maintains the Housing Subsidy System (HSS), which records the delivery of state-subsidised properties post-1994.
- b) The Department of Human Settlements also maintains the National Housing Demand Database (NHDD), which reflects the housing demand.
- 3. None of the 78,658 specified properties have been transferred to date, as National Treasury did not approve the ring-fenced financial provisions that had been made for this purpose.
